Authors are encouraged to submit high quality, original works (theoretical and application-based studies) that have not been published or accepted for publishing by other journals. Full and extended versions of articles presented during the conferences and symposiums could also be submitted but the paper submitting to the journal should differ from the previously published material by at least 50 percent.

Manuscript Sending

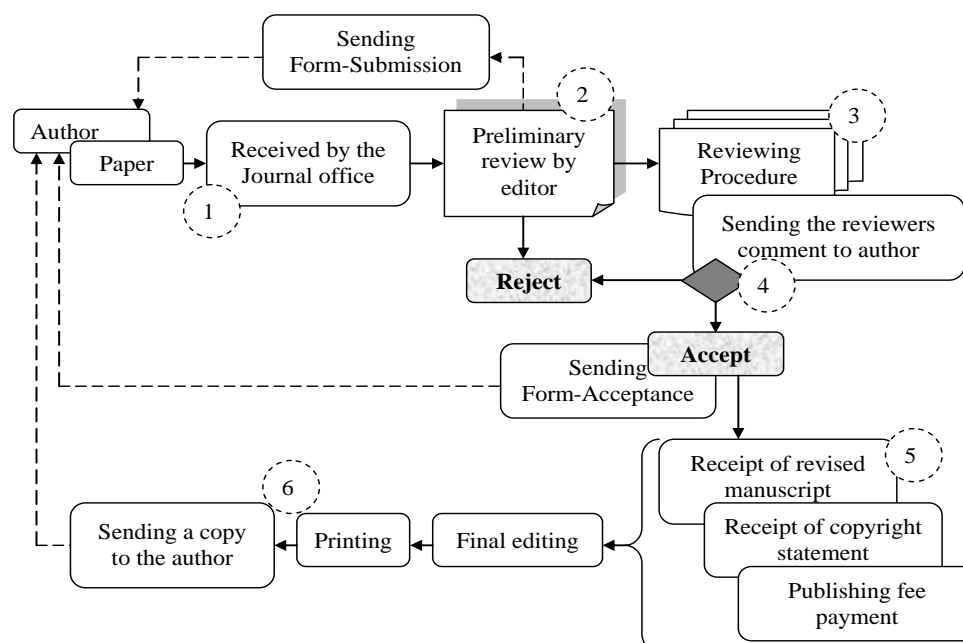
Authors should submit by e-mail an electronic version of the paper as a MS Word 2003 file to the corresponding member of the Technical Board depending on the thematic section. Research articles are usually 8 to 12 pages long. In special cases, shorter or longer articles may be accepted.

Authors are requested to follow the journal guidelines for preparing their manuscripts. An article sample template *TEMPLATE_Journal-IT&S.doc* can be found in the journal web-site (section "Authors' Guidelines"). The manuscript should be accompanied by a separate file with an additional information (Please, download the file *IJITS_Form-1_Submission.rtf* from the section "Paper Submission" of the web-site)

Manuscript Reviewing and Acceptance

Each submitted manuscript will be reviewed by two independent reviewers (experts in the field) and the corresponding author will be informed for the result. A third reviewer could be used if the first two reviews have quite different statements concerning acceptance. The corresponding author will be informed about decision and for the next steps of the publishing procedure (Please, visit the journal web-site for more information).

Copyright

Upon acceptance of the article, author(s) will be asked to transfer copyright of the article to the publisher. This transfer is required for dissemination the issues of the journal in printed and electronic version to the libraries and scientific databases (see the last page).

Deadlines

Regular submissions, but the issues printing is fixed in the beginning of March, June, September and December.
